Sharing our Faith Third Sunday of Advent

The third Sunday of Advent is known as Gaudete Sunday. **Gaudete means 'Rejoice'**. It is a day to be joyful about the coming of Jesus. It

is marked by the lighting of the pink candle on the Advent Wreath.

Today we break from the Gospel of Mark to hear from the Gospel of John, who talks about John the Baptist from a slightly different perspective. John the Baptist here is 'a witness to tell the world about the light'. He is 'sent by God' – a man with a mission, just as we have a mission. The passage calls us to recognise the light here in our world, and to testify in whatever way we are able to that light to others.
