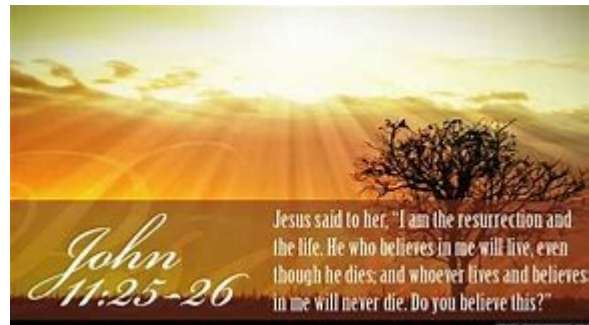
## RESURRECTION SERVICE

The children may be told they are doing 'special work' or 'Booklet work.' They may be encouraged to show everyone how much they have learned in the infant school.

These assessments test the children in their reading, writing and mathematics.
