HOLY WEEK

Holy Week

Holy Week is a very special time of the year in the life of the church and in our school. We remember and celebrate each event of Holy Week in a special way to prepare for the celebration of the Resurrection on Easter Sunday.

On Monday, we remembered **Palm Sunday**. The children listened to the story and watched a short film of Jesus' entrance into Jerusalem. The children made their own palms. It was lovely to see the palms that some of the children had made at home. The school community then gathered onto the playground and welcomed Jesus. They waved their palm branches, sang and shouted "Hosanna". This was then followed by our Big Lent Walk to raise money for CAFOD— Thank you for your generosity.



On Tuesday, we remembered Maundy Thursday and **Jesus' Last Supper**. Each class, took part in their own last supper service, with the class teacher acting in the role of Jesus. Just as Jesus did for the disciples, the class teacher washed the feet of each child and then re-enacted the last supper; sharing bread and wine (blackcurrant juice).



On Wednesday, we remembered in a solemn and beautiful way **Good Friday**. The day Jesus died on the cross. It is always a beautiful sight to see families laying flowers at the foot of the cross as they arrive in the morning. We then gathered as a school community and listened to a simple version of the stations of the cross. Each class then processed outside and each child laid a flower at the foot of the cross. It is always a very moving sight.
