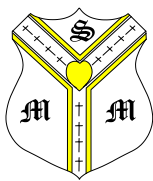

Rise and Shine Big Dance

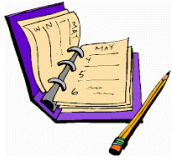
