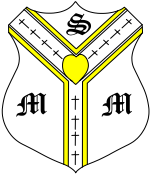

The theme of 'Super Heroes' was shared with the children and they were challenged to think about how to use their special talents and skills to be a **good friend** and to **stop bullying** from happening.

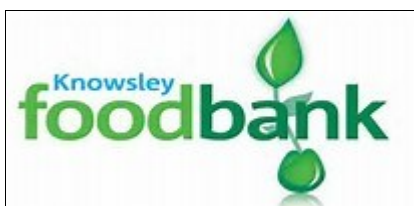
