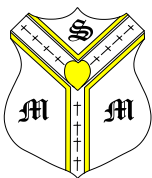

Bobby was educated on Road safety and had never crossed a road before his accident without an adult, this is why his family work so hard to promote road safety as this could happen again to any child.

The children were given lots of reminders and rules about staying safe when crossing roads. This is particularly important for our children as Pilch Lane is so very busy, particularly at the start and end of each school day.
