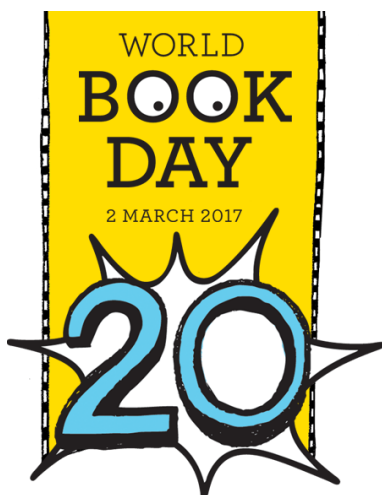

This year's theme is **BED TIME STORIES**.

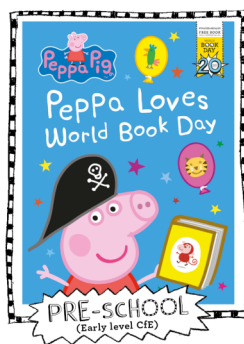
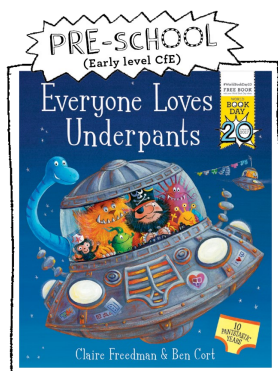
