Nursery 30 Hour Offer

From September 2017, the government will be funding nursery places for 30 hours for children of working parents. Parents living in the family home must be working at least 16 hours a week and earning at least the minimum wage (so for a two parent family both parents should be working and for a single parent family that parent should be working.)

Please note, all three to four year olds are entitled to 15 hours childcare or nursery provision.

To support the 30 hour offer, the governors have decided to make a change to the nursery provision we have on offer. From September 2017, we will have 30 places for 30 hours, as well as our traditional 15 hour part time places.

If you would be interested in a place in our nursery for September, please fill in a form and return it to the office as soon as possible.

Inappropriate Viewing
