Jamie Leigh was an ex-pupil who was much loved by all who met her. She sadly died at the age of 15 in 2016, a few months before her 16 birthday after a long illness.

Her family are now raising money in her memory for families in similar situations. They are hoping to buy a caravan which can be adapted to provide holidays and fun times for families facing similar difficult circumstances.
