All this week the children have been learning about how to be a good friend and what to do if they or a friend have been hurt either physically or emotionally by another person. During our assembly on Monday, Bullybusters taught the children to say, 'STOP, I don't like that' if someone hurt them and to tell an adult they trust.

The theme of this year's Anti-bullying Week was difference. The children have explored how they are different from their friends and how this is something to celebrate. We are a diverse and inclusive school and this is something we are very proud of.

On Tuesday morning, 26 parents and children attended a workshop about staying safe online and what to do about cyberbullying. It was wonderful to see so many children and parents attend the workshop.
