# General Data Protection Regulations Privacy Notice

In line with new regulations coming into force from today, a new privacy notice has been placed on the school website.

This explains what information we collect about your child, why we collect it and what we do with it such as assessment information, contact information and attendance information.

#### **Black School Shoes**



Our school uniform states that only black school shoes are permitted uniform.


