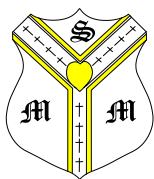

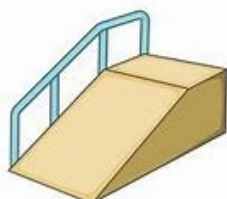
## Polite Request
