Attendance and Punctuality

Many of you, may have received a letter this week about your child's attendance. As you can see above, our target for each child's attendance is 96%. This is around less than half a day absence per fortnight, on average across the year.

Children's punctuality and attendance is extremely important as you cannot teach a child who is not present. Children who maintain good school attendance and punctuality have a better chance of doing well in school and then into adult life. They also form stronger friendships and self confidence.

We do understand that sometimes children are poorly and so the right thing is for them to stay at home until they are well enough to return to school. We want to support all our families to achieve a good school attendance.


