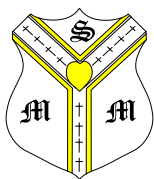

In the same place, by registering a few basic personal details with the Council, you can receive notifications about any changes in the status of the application, for example if it is due to be heard by the Council's planning committee.
