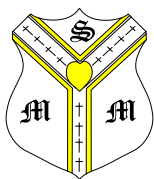

The planning application for a petrol filling station on the land previously occupied by the Boundary PH in Pilch Lane can be found here <https://www.knowsley.gov.uk/view-planning-applications>, using application number "21/00829/FUL". You can view and download copies of the drawings and documents which make up the application and submit any comments you have about the application, which will then be carefully considered by planning officers. In the same place, by registering a few basic personal details with the Council, you can receive notifications about any changes in the status of the application, for example if it is due to be heard by the Council's planning committee.
