On Thursday, we remembered **Maundy Thursday**. Each class took part in their own **Last Supper**. Each child had their feet washed in remembrance of Jesus washing the feet of the disciples. This was then followed by a beautiful re-enactment of the Last Supper.

On Friday, we remembered **Good Friday**. Each year group gathered and listened to a simplified version of the Stations of the Cross. This was followed by each child being invited to lay a flower at the foot of the cross. It is always a very moving service and Father Ian was able to join us for the Year 2 service in the morning. It was beautiful to witness the care in which children and families lay their flowers down in the morning.
