Early Years Outdoor Provision

Our new outdoor provision is almost complete and is now ready for the nursery and reception children to use. I am sure you will agree that the new equipment will become a real asset to our children and aid them in developing in so many ways; physically, socially and academically.

The equipment is strictly for school lesson time and to be supervised by school staff. It must never be used by older children, particularly junior school children. There are three main reasons for this:

- School has invested a considerable amount of money into this equipment and it must last for a very long time. We cannot afford for it to be damaged by children using it who are older than it is designed for.
- 2. We wish to avoid injuries. There have been incidents of equipment being used unsupervised outside of school hours and accidents taking place.
- 3. We wish it to remain 'special' for the children to use in their lessons to help them to be excited about their learning.
